Primary services and program activities include informational orientations, online application assistance, access to computers, internet and fax, translation, and support for low-income Spanish-speaking members with limited access to technology. The goal of the program is to help community members receive equitable access to resources.

Asian Community Development Council

Community Supports



The Asian Community Development Council advocates for the growing underserved Asian population in the greater Nevada community by delivering quality programming and services in healthcare access and education, direct relief to address growing housing and food insecurity, workforce and leadership development, immigration education, and civic engagement. The Community Language Access Support Program will recruit, retain, and develop bi-lingual client success advocates for the top 5 AAPI languages spoken in Southern Nevada to strengthen access to culturally and linguistically appropriate programs and services for Asian and Pacific Islander families with limited English proficiency. The intended impact is to expand language access and intake capacity for direct community relief including community navigation and language support.

Program activities include homework support, games, library visits, reading, and arts and crafts. The goal of the organization is to is to provide youth with opportunities to achieve educational success.

Activities include experiences such as leadership events and externship visits to allow students to learn from other community organizations and gain exposure to many professional industries and fields.

Fulfillment Fund of Las Vegas is dedicated to inspiring first-generation students and removing barriers to post-secondary access and post-secondary graduation. Through their **Fulfillment Fundamentals Program**, they aim to leveragage student achievement through school partnerships and community outreach-centered post-secondary access programming. Program activities include college-access curriculum lessons, post-secondary education workshops, and community outreach events to help students and their families get to post-secondary education.



Future Smiles strives to increase access to oral health care for underserved populations. Through the **Future Smiles traveling dental program**, dental hygienists and assistants with portable dental units provide dental hygiene education, oral health supplies, dental sealants, enamel repair, fluoride varnish applications, and referrals for students in Title 1 CCSD and charter schools, Pre-K centers, and community centers in Clark County. By providing routine access to dental health education, Future Smiles intends to improve children's understanding of dental health, decrease dental pain and urgent care visits to address dental related issues, and increase children's quality of life.

Gay and Lesbian Center of Southern Nevada

The LGBTQ Center of Southern Nevada supports and celebrates the diversity of our community and strives to empower all to live authentic lives. Through the reimagination of the Identi-T Program, which provides transgender programming and services, they host peer-facilitated support groups as well as services for economic, housing, and rights advocacy. Expansion of this program will allow The Center to better serve the emotional, social, physical, and economic well-being for more people with relevant and meaningful services that strengthens the trans community.

Girls on the Run Las Vegas

Girls on the Run Las Vegas inspires girls to be joyful, healthy and confident using a fun, experience-based curriculum which creatively integrates running and self-esteem. Their activities include participating in a team-based community service project, a non-competitive 5k run event, a curriculum in socio-emotional development, and the recruitment of many diverse mentors and coaches.

Jobs 4 Nevada Graduates is dedicated to supporting students at risk of not graduating at Chaparral High School located in east Las Vegas. Through their program **J4NG**, **an in-school intervention program** that works with students facing significant barriers to graduation and entry into career pathways, they provide one on one support to change the trajectory of their participants. They offer program activities such as elective credit classes, club activities, mentoring, wraparound supports, and follow up after graduation.

Junior Achievement of Southern Nevada

Jr. Achievement of Southern Nevada is dedicated to supporting students at risk in Southern Nevada schools. Through the **Empowerment Initiative**, they aim to enable students to understand business, citizenship, economics, financial literacy, entrepreneurship, ethics, and work readiness through after school activities and presentation. Program activities include business volunteer presentations in classrooms, guidebooks and workshops, role play exercises, and games. The goal of the program is to provide students with the opportunity to engage in educational programming outside of school hours to increase grade-level promotion.

Leaders in Training

Leaders in Training works to build stronger, healthier communities as a lead advocate, coalition-builder, and direct service provider to ensure economic self-sufficiency. The program empowers first-generation high school students from low-income families to obtain college-level education. The organization emphasizes college access, leadership development, and financial education. The goal of the program is to help students become competitive college applicants as they obtain real-world work and leadership experience.

Nevada HAND

Community Supports



Nevada HAND supports the lives of low-income residents and their families by providing affordable housing with on-site, wrap-around supportive services. Through the **Wrap-around Services for Local Low-income Residents of Affordable Housing Program**, low-income families living in Nevada HAND's residential units can benefit from access to on-site supportive services integrated into the affordable communities where they live. Nevada HAND is committed to providing equitable access to resources like food pantries, shuttle services, social services, educational workshops, and after-school activities to all. These year-round on-site services serve to reduce isolation, promote educational attainment, develop life skills, and promote health decision-making.

The Public Education Foundation is dedicated to supporting the community and the Clark County School District to meet immediate, critical education needs that will strengthen our public schools and students. Program activities include workshops and presentations to all attending students about applying for and receiving scholarships and federal aid before graduation. Through their **Survivor Enrichment Program**, they aim to survivors of domestic and sexual violence, including trafficking, with job skills and experience to allow them to support their families without having to rely on a partner and risk becoming trapped in an abusive relationship again. Goals of this organization are to assist residents with services and activities including counseling, advocacy, employment opportunities, job training, childcare, transportation, and financial education.

Solutions of Change supports children, young adults, and their families who have a diagnosable mental, behavioral, or emotional disorder identify, learn, and apply positive solutions to assist in building better self-sufficiency and life skills. Through the **Thriving Youth and Families Mental Health Program,** Solutions of Change offers culturally and linguistically appropriate services and responsive individualized, family, and group therapeutic counseling, behavior management coaching, peer-to-peer mentoring, parent training, and comprehensive case management for youth, young adults, and their families.

Spread the Word Nevada is dedicated to supporting childhood literacy in elementary students in low-income communities in Southern Nevada. Through the **Books & Buddies Mentor Centers**, they aim to serve children from kindergarten to 5th grade with in-school mentorship that bridges school and family supports to bolster children's literacy growth by providing programming that will develop reading proficiency, comprehension, and verbal recitation skills. Students are also given copies of the books and program materials to take home to practice and enjoy with their families. Program goals include increasing students' progression for future learning and grade promotion.

St. Jude's Ranch for Children

St. Jude's Ranch for Children is dedicated to transforming the lives of abused and at-risk children, young adults, and families by empowering them to create new chances, new choices, and new hope in a caring community.
